

Hebrews 1:1-3—"Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature; and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high."

Heir—

Ps. 2:8—"Ask of me, and I will make the nations your heritage, and the ends of the earth your possession."

Mt. 28:18—"All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me"

John 1:3—"All things were made through him, and without him was not anything made that was made."

Rom. 8:16, 17—"The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ"

Gal. 4:7—"So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God."

1Pet. 1:3-4—"He has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you."

1Cor. 3:21-23—"So let no one boast in men. For all things are yours, whether Paul or Apollos or Cephas or the world or life or death or the present or the future—all are yours, and you are Christ's, and Christ is God's."

Creator—

Ps. 102:25-27—"You, Lord, laid the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the work of your hands; they will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment, like a robe you will roll them up, like a garment they will be changed. But you are the same, and your years will have no end."

John 1:3—"All things were made through him, and without him was not any thing made that was made."

Col. 1:16—"For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominion or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him."

Radiance—

Ex. 33:18-19—"Moses said, 'Please show me your glory.' And he said, 'I will make all my goodness pass before you and will proclaim before you my name 'THE LORD'."

Matt. 17:1-5—"And after six days Jesus took with him Peter and James, and John his brother, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. And he was transfigured before them and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became white as light ... He was still speaking when behold, a

bright cloud overshadowed them, and a voice from th cloud said, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him."

Exact Imprint—

John 14:9—To Philip, "Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father?'"

Col. 1:15—"He is the image of the invisible God, the first born of all creation."

Purification—

Matt. 1:21—"She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.

Gal. 1:4—"who gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen"

Eph. 1:7—"In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace."

1Cor 15:3—"For I delivered to you as of first importance what I also received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the Scriptures."

1John 4:10—"In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins."
