





- What did these three men experience?
 - Life or death decision. (3:1-5)
 - Threat. (3:6-7)
 - Standing out in the Crowd. (3:8-12)
 - The WRATH of a King. (3:13-15)
- Words HAVE consequences. (3:16-18)
 - PEACE in the presence of God AND danger. (3:19-27)

Three lessons revealed to us through the trial by fire:

1.The good news of the Gospel is NOT that God will make life EASIER. The good news of the Gospel, for THIS life, is that He will make our lives BETTER.
